The Behavior Health Therapist performs work involving the clinical assessment, diagnosis and treatment of mental health needs of clients of Insight Counseling & Wellness, LLC. The Behavioral Health Therapist works closely with the client to develop the appropriate treatment plan to move the client toward the desired change. The Behavior Health Therapist works collaboratively with a peer supervision team to monitor the course of treatment.

Essential qualifications:

- \* Master's degree in a behavioral health field
- \* Fully licensed as an LMFT, LPC or LCSW; trainees working toward full licensure will not be considered
- \* Ability to work in collaboration with a variety of behavioral health disciplines including case managers, psychotherapists, and body-centered therapists including yoga therapists and dance therapists
- \* Knowledge of and demonstrated skill in providing culturally sensitive, trauma-informed services
- \* Strong organizational skills, excellent verbal and written communication skills
- \* Ability to be flexible and creative
- \* Ability to utilize Telehealth platforms for psychotherapy and clinic meetings as necessary

- \* Licensed as a CSAC, SAC or SUD specialty
- \* Experience working with children, families and adults with serious mental health and/or substance use concerns in a community setting
- \* Credentialed in good standing with Dane County's Comprehensive Community Services

Responsibilities

- \* Performs accurate assessments to evaluate and diagnose mental health and/or co-occurring issues in a culturally sensitive, recovery oriented, trauma-sensitive manner.
- \* Provides a range of clinical services including assessment, treatment planning, psychotherapy and referrals in a context that is supportive of the consumer's culture, values and perspectives.
- \* Completes accurate clinical records including intakes, assessments, treatment plans and updates, progress notes, discharge summaries and other information in a timely manner.
- \* Maintains minimum direct service hour expectations.
- \* Attends staff meetings, in-services and other program activities as requested.
- \* Serve as on-call therapist approximately 3-4 weeks per year
- \* Represent the clinic and its mission and values to other agencies and the general public
